The day that I write this newsletter article feels full of awful news. Last night we watched images on the news of the devastation of the tornadoes in Mississippi, and of the school shooting in Tennessee. We heard the news that Shenkel's former interim minister has died suddenly. And our member Judy Miller is in the hospital recovery from hip surgery after her fall on Sunday! That is not even mentioning the members working to regain health and strength after strokes, Covid, and chemo or those no longer allowed to drive. Sometimes we want to shout STOP! Enough of the catastrophes and bad news, we can't take anymore!

Our hearts break with the pain of the world and even more intensely with the pain of those we know and love. What are we to do with it all? How do we keep going?

I like to take a cue from Jesus' life and work. The Gospel of Luke is the one that most often records that Jesus withdrew, alone, to pray. When I think of all the demands on Jesus' time and his compassion, I see how it would be important for him to withdraw once in a while to remember who he was and what his mission was on earth. We can follow his example. It doesn't need to be for days at a time or even hours, just withdraw and spend some time in solitude, remembering who you are and whose you are; God's beloved child.

Remember Jesus' invitation from Matthew chapter 11, "Come to me all you who are weary and carrying heavy burdens, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn of me, for I am gentle and humble of heart and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light."

As we move into the season of spring and you hear the birds and see the flowers and trees blooming, pause, take a deep breath, and rest in the one who offers to help you carry your burdens and give ease to your weary soul. God is not absent; Jesus is risen!


