FINANCIALS

In December, the Congregation approved the 2025 budget, which will be discussed in greater depth at the Annual meeting. We finished the year with strong December giving. Giving, in combination with monies from the Carol Challenge and changes to how we funded some budget lines, allowed us to end the year with a positive balance in the Current Fund of \$3,169. OCWM giving was short by \$2,614. The shortfall was made up using Program/Mission funds.
